RELATIONS WITH YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS

In keeping with its policy of providing the best possible educational opportunities for all students, the board may consider properly submitted proposals for intersession activities offering short-term explorations of areas which are adjunct to or outside the traditional curriculum. Whenever appropriate, the board shall co-sponsor such activities with a bona fide youth organization, such as Scouts, YMCA/YWCA, Girl Scouts, and the like.

Proposals shall be judged on their educational value, relevance to the students' educational level and interests, and the availability of funds, adequate supervision, and transportation.

The administration shall work out each viable proposal in detail with the co-sponsoring organization prior to its submission to the board for final approval, in accordance with board policy on intersession activities.

The board shall encourage efforts by the staff, the students, youth organizations, and the community to make the widest possible range of educational experiences available to the children of the district. Students shall be encouraged to take an active part in the planning and implementation of approved activities.
