

Counselor's Corner- Why Attendance Matters

DID YOU KNOW?

•Starting in kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.

•Missing 10 percent (or about 18 days) can make it harder to learn to read.

•Students can still fall behind if they miss just a day or two days every few weeks.

•Absences can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

- •Set a regular bed time and morning routine
- •Lay out clothes and pack backpack the evening before

•Don't let your child stay home unless she is truly sick. Keep in mind complaints of a stomach ache or headache can be a sign of anxiety and not a reason to stay home.

•Develop back-up plans for getting to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, a neighbor, or another parent.
