

WEST LINN HIGH SCHOOL HONORS GRADUATE PROGRAM

Criteria:

1. Students must have the following AP/Honors-designated courses and cumulative GPA:
6 AP/Honors class credits (12 semester long courses) and 3.6 weighted, cumulative GPA or higher.
2. **Students must earn at least 2 credits (4 semester long courses) from Humanities AP/Honors courses and 2 credits (4 semester long courses) from Math/Science AP/Honors courses.**
3. Students must have been an active participant in at least one co-curricular activity during their Junior or Senior year (e.g. athletics, clubs, theater, music, etc.).
4. **In extenuating circumstances, students can request to drop one AP/Honors course.** Students will lose Honor Grad status if they drop **more than one** AP/Honors course.
5. Students must take all AP/Honors courses for a grade.
6. Students must have met all mandated Essential Skills requirements (State Assessments) in Reading, Writing, and Math.
7. Students must complete 20 hours or more of community service. NHS or other WLHS content area honor society hours may be used. If student is not a member of one of these groups, verification of their hours must be turned in to the office.
8. GPA for Honors Graduates is tabulated from the **weighted grading scale.**
9. Grades will be verified at 3rd quarter of the senior year for official Honor Grad status.

- Valedictorian and Salutatorian must be Honor Graduates.
- Valedictorian and Salutatorian will be recognized at graduation.
- There may be an open audition for student speakers at graduation.
