You (or your student) will be taking your AP Exam(s) shortly. Please see the exam schedule attached to this letter. Exams will be given either at West Linn High School or Rolling Hills Church this year. We will be busing all students from West Linn High School to Rolling Hills Church (no student or parent will be allowed to drop off, pick up, or drive separately).

If your student has a morning exam, they are to report to the designated WLHS location by 7:00AM or 7:30AM (depending on exam location), so if they don't drive they will need a ride to school that day. If your student has an afternoon exam they will report to the designated WLHS location by 11:00AM or 11:30AM (depending on exam location) and may not return to WLHS until 4:00PM or 4:30PM, so if they don't drive they will need a ride home from school that day.

You should bring the following items to the exam room:

- Your photo ID (student body card or driver's license)
- A watch (in case your exam room does not have a clock that you can see easily, but make sure it doesn't have an alarm or beeping noise).
- Up to two calculators and extra batteries with the necessary capabilities if you are taking an AP Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, or Statistics Exam. (Visit www.collegeboard.com/ap/calculators to learn more about the calculator policy for each of these exams, and for a list of authorized calculators.)
- Sack lunch (if taking two exams on the same day)
- Dress in layers

You should not bring the following to the exam room:

- Electronic equipment: (cell phone, smart phone, tablet computer, etc.), portable listening or recording devices (MP3 player, iPod, etc.), cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the Internet, and any other electronic or communication devices.
- Pencils/Pens – we will provide these for you
- Unapproved aids: Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, colored pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.
- Rulers, straightedges, and protractors
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets or, for Chinese Language and Culture and Japanese Language and Culture, on scratch paper provided by the proctor).
- Computers or calculators (except as noted above).
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- Watches that beep or have an alarm
- Clothing with subject-related information
- Food or drink in exam room

Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended. Do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam, as your request will be denied. If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation, and arrangements should be made accordingly. Your absence from your regular classes will be excused.

During the exam only one student will be allowed to leave the room at a time to use the restroom, so encourage your student to go beforehand.

Get a good night's rest before your exam, and eat a nutritious breakfast. The school will provide water and a snack for the 10-minute break. However, eating is prohibited in the exam room. It is advisable to bring a sweater, in case the room temperature is below your comfort level.

You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and West Linn High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam score.

Students will NOT receive score reports in the mail. Students must sign up for a free College Board account online, which they'll need to access their scores in July. Please go to <https://apscore.collegeboard.org/scores> to sign up and learn more about online score reporting.
