Digital World: Technology Resources

Curious which applications are best for your kids? Not sure how much screen time is too much or want to talk with your child about internet safety? Then please check-out this amazing website. One of the most comprehensive resources on this topic is Common Sense Media: www.commonsensemedia.org.

In a previous newsletter article, Ms. Donegan shared how we utilize resources from Common Sense Media in our library lessons that focus on digital citizenship. A digital citizen is someone who chooses to act in a safe, respectful way, and is responsible online. We would like our students to understand the differences between responsibilities in offline and online communities, refine online searches for better results, distinguish between information that is safe to share online and that which is not, articulate when it is acceptable to use other people's work and know how to write a citation and develop strategies for safely managing unwanted messages.

In addition to educator resources, there is a plethora of other resources on that website geared specifically for parents. There are family guides and reviews of T.V. shows, movies, essential school tools, books and applications for smart phones and tablets. These technological mediums are rated by other parents just like you. There is also section devoted to the *Common Sense Seal*, which recognizes films that delight families with enriching, relatable stories and positive messages and role models. One of my favorite parts of the website is the section completely devoted to parent concerns. There are FAQs, articles and videos with various topics including Screen Time, Internet Safety and Social Media to name a few. There is also a parent blog with even more useful, updated information and resources. In today's digital world, information and input are coming at us from all directions. It is helpful that a resource like Common Sense Media exists to help us navigate the complex technological world in which we live.


