KINDERGARTEN & DUAL LANGUAGE PROGRAM ENROLLMENT

Kindergarten registration for the 2015-2016 school year has begun! A full day program will be provided to all kindergartners next year. Parents may pick up registration forms from any of our primary schools or download all forms at http://www.wlwv.k12.or.us/Page/376. Completed forms can be returned to the office. While there is no need to rush your enrollment, we encourage families to enroll as soon as possible to help us accurately determine staffing needs for next year. If you have a neighbor or friend with a kindergartener for next year, please forward this information to him or her.

Dual Language (Spanish) Kindergarten Programs are available at Trillium Creek and Lowrie Primary Schools. This is the entry for the K-5 district dual language program. Enrollment for the Dual Language Kindergarten Program is subject to a lottery process should interest exceed the class capacity, therefore the registration is due by January 30, 2015. The lottery will be held on February 3, 2015 if needed.
