Advanced College Credit Partnership with Clackamas Community College

The ACC program is a cooperative educational effort between high schools and colleges to offer college-level courses for students to receive pre-approved college credit for some of the classes currently taught in high schools. The courses are taught by approved, qualified high school teachers. Students are eligible for the college credit (known as "dual credit") if they complete the course curriculum as approved by the college. "Dual credit" is both high school and college credit in most cases. All Oregon community and State System colleges and universities accept the dual credits when properly transferred and submitted on the cooperating college's official transcript. Students going to private or out-of-state colleges should contact the specific colleges to determine if ACC is transferable.

The College:

- 1. Provides information and registration instructions via the ACC website at http://depts.clackamas.edu/acc. Flyers are also provided in class.
- 2. Charges a \$10.00 per college credit fee. A significant savings to standard tuition costs.
- 3. Creates/maintains a student record for all ACC students and transcripts credit earned.
- 4. Provides free, unofficial transcripts through the myClackamas student management system and a process for ordering official transcripts at www.getmytranscript.com.

The Student:

- Is responsible for registering on-line for the college credit within the registration timelines posted at the ACC website. Registration instruction flyers will be provided in class and are available at the ACC website under the HS Course Lists tab. Click on the high school class title.
- 2. Pays the \$10.00 per college credit fee to the College. Payment can be made on-line, in person or by mail
- 3. Meets all Clackamas Community College deadlines for registration, dropping and payment.
