## Campaigning Regulations Contract

The following are the ASB campaigning guidelines: **if you fail to follow them you will be disqualified from the election.** You are expected to run this your campaign with integrity and honor.

If you touch or remove anyone else's campaign material you will be disqualified from the election  
If you talk negatively about the election or any of the candidates, either in person or on social media you will be disqualified from the election. Focus on "you" and running a positive campaign!

The total value of your campaigning materials **may not exceed \$100.00** – donated and purchased; be prepared to show your receipts. This includes the approximate value of materials already available to you; for example, art supplies at home; office or printing supplies at a parent's workplace, etc.

You may not use school supplies to create campaigning materials.

**You may not use handout items- (NO CANDY, stickers, food, toys) These are basically bribes and create trash, distraction and waste.**

If you make T-shirts- they must also contain only positive messages and use appropriate language.

**REMEMBER YOUR BUDGET!!!**

### POSTERS

You may put up a maximum of **TEN** campaign posters/flyers on campus

- They cannot to exceed 24x36 inches
- Posters/flyers may only be posted with **BLUE TAPE ONLY! NO CLEAR TAPE!!!**
- No Posters on the doors to the buildings!
- No posters in the PAC- only the main building
- No writing on Teachers' White Boards or posting in classrooms
- Teachers and staff need to remain neutral
- NO GLITTER.

All Posters must be taken down and cleaned up afterschool on May 21st- failure to do so could result in disqualifications
