- D. Analysis = relate the article to economics using 3 or more economic note-card concepts, for each concept answer why this is important to economics. Yes, this is about a paragraph per term of connecting the term to this news story and then explaining what the economical importance is of this term in this situation.
- E. Your opinion and ideas = 5 -7 sentences state your opinion, reflect upon the topic, go beyond the article to **connect with your own life and experiences**. 5 points
