Human Impact on the Environment Project Requirements

<u>1. Choose a Topic</u>: Choose a topic of interest from the list provided or come up with a topic not on the list involving a specific human impact on the environment. If you come up with your own topic, make sure to speak with your teacher to make sure the topic is of significant complexity and rigor.

<u>2. Topic Description</u>: Research your topic in order to describe and explain the environmental issues that arise due to this your specific human impact.

<u>3. Make Connections</u>: Connect the topics we have been discussing in class with the issue you chose to research. Does your human impact arise due to population growth? Is climate change a result of your specific impact?... how can they be connected?

<u>4. Solutions</u>: What solutions have been made to address this problem if any. What are some alternative ways to get the same things without harming the environment? If no solutions are out there yet, what solutions can you propose?

<u>5. Personal Thoughts</u>: What personal thoughts and opinions do you have on this topic? You must take a stance, form and explain your opinion. Why do you feel the way that you do about the topic?

<u>6. Key Vocabulary</u>: List any new significant vocabulary words that a viewer of your poster will need in order to understand the issue on which you chose to do research.
