ESSENTIAL SKILLS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

Students are required to demonstrate proficiency in the following Essential Skills. This requirement will be achieved by earning a "meets or exceeds" score on the appropriate statewide assessment test.

- Read and comprehend a variety of text
- Write clearly and accurately
- Apply mathematics in a variety of settings

Wilsonville High School will provide multiple options for students to demonstrate proficiency in the set of Essential Skills. Students will demonstrate their mastery of the Essential Skills by:

- Achieving a state-determined score on the state assessment tests in English language arts and math; or
- Achieving a state-determined score on another standardized test (SAT, ACT, etc.); or
- Completing an approved locally scored assessment, such as a work sample or student project

COLLEGE BOUND STUDENTS

Students planning to attend a four-year college or university should complete the following minimum requirements in English, Science, Mathematics, Social Science, Performing Arts, and World Language.

Students planning to attend a community college should complete high school graduation requirements. Community colleges also require incoming students to take a placement exam in reading, writing, and math. Wilsonville High School students can complete the placement exam in the College & Career Center.
