
## Eight grade parents only:

Please do not staple, tape or glue your photo to the order form. Please do not draw on the photo. Photos from books cannot be accepted. ## The preferred methods of submitting photos is:

- 1. As an email attachment to Kat Budiao at budiaok@wlwv.k12.or.us (minimum of 800 x 1200 dpi) jpeg format.
- 2. On a CD (minimum of 800 x 1200 dpi).
- **3.** A **copy of a photo** using photo paper. The local UPS store, Rite-Aid and Target have the ability to produce copies of photos.
- **4.** If you must submit a **hardcopy photo, and want it returned,** please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
