


双语思维全脑开发 Building Bilingual Brains

Research shows that:

- Reading skills and comprehension in first language (L1) transfer to reading in a second language (L2).
- Math knowledge in L1 transfers to math knowledge in L2.
- The brain needs time and strategic instruction to develop bilingualism and bi-literacy. This is a 5-7 year developmental process.
- Language is the foundation for all literacy.







双语和思维能力之间存在联系

There is a connection between bilingualism and thinking skills.



- Improved working memory
- Superior executive control (ability to choose among alternatives)
- Better selective attention





中英双语模式 Chinese Dual Language Model

- Research and a study of programs in Oregon and across the U.S. confirms
 the importance of providing instruction in literacy and mathematics in both
 languages, Chinese and English, throughout primary and middle school.
- Students will not be repeating what they learned in one language in the other language but instead have planned learning so they learn and have practice with the standards and key skills in both languages.





Pillars of Dual Language Education





双语教育途径 Dual Language Pathway



Begin growing vocabulary and understanding through listening, speaking, reading and writing while learning content in language arts and math. Learn language and cultural differences and to appreciate and understand them.



项目模式 / Program Model

- Children will learn Mandarin Chinese.
- At this point, based on the small number of students whose first language is Chinese, this will be a one-way program.
- This means the teachers are the primary source of language learning and practice in the classroom because almost all students speak English as their first language.
- The learning model is the same as it is for a program where half of the children speak Chinese as their first language.
- It is a 50:50 model, meaning students learn about half of their day in Chinese and half of their day in English.
- A 50:50 model is used by virtually all Chinese Dual Language programs in the U.S.
- Research supports the 50:50 model.
- The Spanish Dual Language program in our district also uses the 50:50 model.

中英双语模式 Chinese Dual Language Model-Team Teaching

- One teacher instructs in the target language (Chinese), and other teacher in English.
- Teachers exchange students throughout the day.
- Teachers collaborate and plan instruction together to best meet the needs of the student.

50:50 Model	Teacher A (Chinese Teacher)	Teacher B (English Teacher)
Morning	Teaches Chinese Literacy and math in target language to class "A"	Teaches English literacy and other designated subjects to class "B"
Afternoon	Teaches Chinese Literacy and math in target language to class "B".	Teaches English literacy and other designated submes to class "A".



What does it mean to be a dual language school and district?

- Children in the Chinese DL classrooms will work with the reading and math curriculum that is used across district schools, K-5.
- Dual Language students experience the same science, social studies, music, and physical education as other children at their grade level.
- Dual Language teachers and non-DL teachers plan learning and activities together.
- Students in Dual Language receive the same support if they have IEPs, 504 Plans or are TAG identified.
- We are committed to a K-12 Chinese Dual Language Program. The middle school program will be at Athey Creek and there will be Chinese DL courses at Riverside HS.





Learning math in Kindergarten










Instruction in English

- Students will have explicit foundational skills including phonological awareness and phonics in English starting in kindergarten.
- English reading and writing will be part of the daily literacy instruction starting in kindergarten.
- English instruction is taught by a native English speaker.
