WHAT is the FAFSA?

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid
- Federal document that students and parents complete using previous year tax information (2019 tax info for the class of 2021)

Why Complete the FAFSA?

- Colleges use information to determine eligibility for grants, loans and work-study funds in college.
- Completing the FAFSA is FREE and quick.

When Do Students Complete the FAFSA?

- After October 1 of senior year, and every year while attending college

WHAT is the ORSAA?

- Oregon Student Aid Application
- Alternative to FAFSA for undocumented students (including those with DACA status)

Why Complete the ORSAA

- Colleges use information to determine eligibility for grants, scholarships and tuition reduction funds in college.
- Undocumented and DACA students are not eligible for federal aid.

When Do Students Complete the ORSAA?

- After October 1 of senior year, and every year while attending college
