### Parking Lot Reminders

Keeping children and adults safe in our parking lot while keeping traffic moving smoothly is a top priority. Foremost, remember to drive slowly, watch carefully, and drop off children only in designated areas. Thank you for your diligent, courteous care for all children at Boones Ferry!

- If you park in a parking space, walk your children to the main crosswalk in front of school.
- When dropping off your children, pull all the way forward to stop, but not past the cross walk in the fire lane or first lane.
- Drop off in a timely manner to keep traffic moving.
- Have your child exit your car on the curbside/passenger side of the car only.

*Use extreme caution while exiting the parking lot, following crossing guard directions.*

with no health insurance or who are covered by OHP**

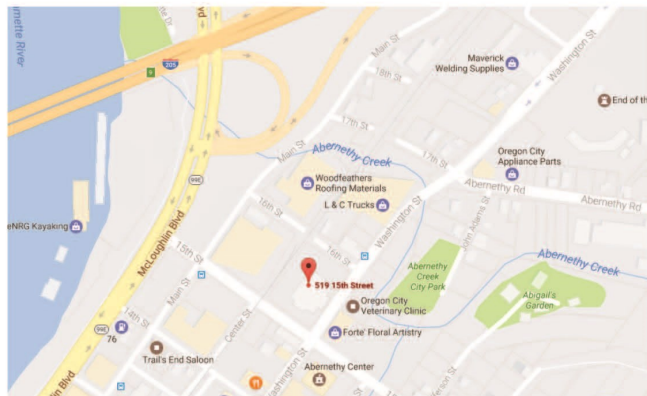
**5 - 7 p.m., Wednesday, February 7 & 14, 2018**  
**Walk-in only – appointments not available**

Vaccines will be provided free of charge to children with no health insurance, OHP or children with insurance that does not cover the cost of immunizations. All immunizations required by the State of Oregon for children will be available. Please bring any immunization records you have to the clinic. **A parent or guardian must be present and sign an authorization form for children under age 15.**

In the case of inclement weather, if the North Clackamas School District is closed the clinic will be cancelled.
