All 5th grade families have (3) options to recognize their 5th grader as part of the yearbook. Our goal is that EACH 5TH GRADER either orders a yearbook or receives it as a gifted donation because there is a YEARBOOK SIGNING EVENT as part of 5th grade celebration in June.

1.) YEARBOOK + SINGLE PHOTO SUBMISSION 5TH GRADE AD = \$20.00 - A low cost way for you to recognize your 5th grader. Submit a single high resolution photo (typically 250KB or higher).

****NOTE:** saved photos from social media will not work - some email programs reduce photo quality. Consider using Dropbox or a photo sharing site. Also email **10-12 WORDS** (including 'Love, Mom' or 'Family') to bfpsyearbook@gmail.com. Order forms, words and photos are due on **FRIDAY, MARCH 2ND**! If you are concerned about your photo being high enough resolution, please plan to submit prior to that day. Includes the cost of a yearbook!

2.) YEARBOOK ORDER ONLY = \$18.00 - The early bird rate to order a yearbook is **FRIDAY, MARCH 2ND**. Once yearbooks come in June, a small number of books will be available on a first come, first serve basis for \$25 in the front office.

3.) YEARBOOK + 5TH GRADE AD = \$40.00 - \$80.00 - Purchase a **1/4**, **1/2** or **FULL PAGE** advertisement in the yearbook as you celebrate their 5th Grade Promotion! Includes the cost of (1) yearbook. You have the option to order additional yearbooks. - Submit the text you would like to include on the advertisement - Suggestions for word amount:

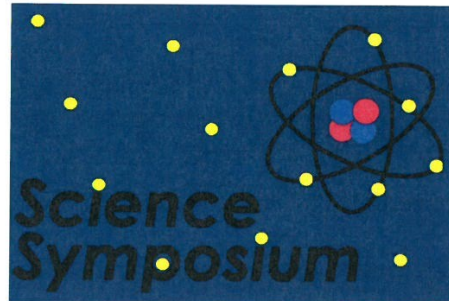
