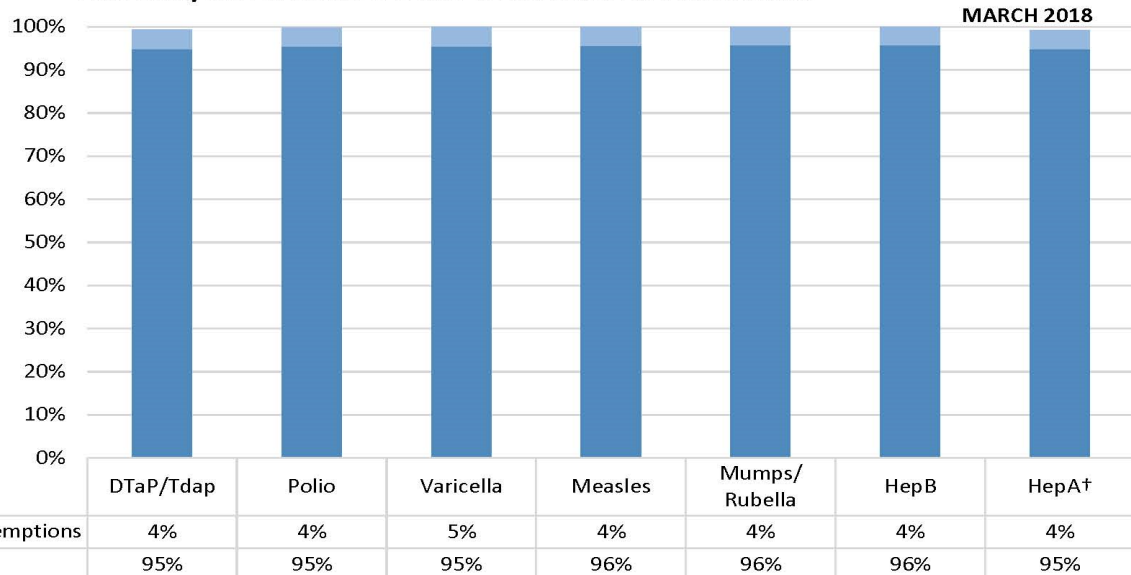

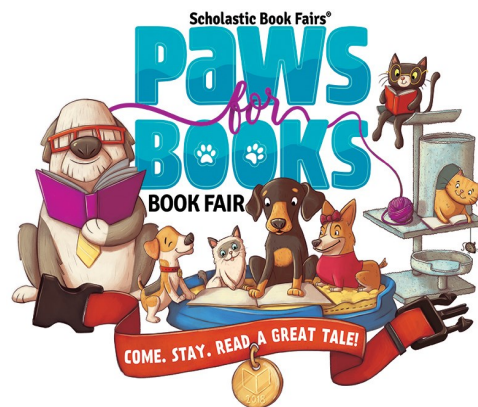

It's "PAWTY" Time at Boones Ferry Book Fair May 14-18th

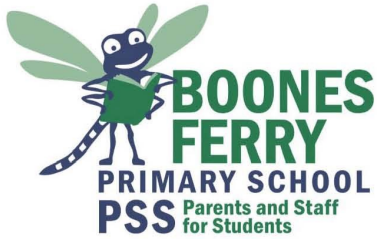
Find a great book at our "Paws for Books" Book Fair!
