¹ Time starts when the alarm is activated and stops when the last person is out of the building.

² Students should practice evacuating under a variety of circumstances. A drill should occur during regular classes, gym, an assembly, recess, and with staged obstacles, such as a blocked exit or missing students.

³ All employees must receive training in fire prevention, evacuation, and fire safety in accordance with OFC Sections 406.31 – 406.3.4.

⁴ All students must receive at least 30 minutes of instruction on fire, earthquake, and tsunami dangers (where appropriate), and fire drills each month per ORS 336.071.
