*** An adverb describes **HOW** and **HOW OFTEN** you do something. Basically, it gives more detailed information about what's going on.

Example: I play basketball well. I play basketball every Friday.

*** Most adverbs in English come from adding an –LY to a description word.

Example: She runs. She is a quick runner. She runs quickly.

Verb verb description verb adverb

HOW - ¿Cómo?

*** To make a how adverb, take an adjective, make it feminine and add –mente. If there's an accent, keep the accent mark where it is.

Example: bonito ---> bonita ---> bonitamente rápido ---> rápida ---> rápidamente

*** The adverb of "bueno" is "bien." The adverb of "malo" is "mal." "Así así" never changes.

*** On the back of this sheet, you can find more descriptions to make adverbs.

HOW OFTEN - ¿Con qué frecuencia?

*** To ask how often somebody does something, use "¿Con qué frecuencia?"
