

Los Artículos y Los Plurales

***In Spanish, articles are a little different than in English, because there are masculine and feminine words. So, in order to say A, Some, or The, there are 8 ways to do it.

Indefinite articles (A or Some) Use these when you're **not** talking about a specific object.

	Masculine	Feminine
Single	UN	UNA
Plural	UNOS	UNAS

Examples: *Un libro. Una pluma. Unos libros. Unas plumas.*

Definite articles (The) Use these when you **are** talking about a specific object.

	Masculine	Feminine
Single	EL	LA
Plural	LOS	LAS

Examples: *El libro. La pluma. Los libros. Las plumas.*

Plural words

***If a word ends in a **vowel**, you add "**S**".

El libro ---> Los libros

***If a word ends in a **consonant**, you add "**ES**".

El marcador ---> Los marcadores

***If a word already ends in an "**S**", you **don't change** the word (just change the **article**).

El martes ---> Los martes

***If a word ends in a "**Z**", change the "**Z**" to "**C**" and then add "**ES**".

El lápiz ---> Los lápices
