

## How will Students Demonstrate Learning?

## We have many options ... what is best for the student?

Passing an exam or completing a work product to demonstrate essential learning.

Independent studies centering on a project that incorporates priority standards from one or more courses in order for students to earn credit in more than one course.

Extended time for learning, such as an optional course period or a for-credit project must be complete prior to the 2021-2022 school year

Demonstrating mastery through successful completion of the next course in the learning progression.



Be flexible and allow students to select the mode of response to match their context, strengths, and interests. Families with mobile devices may take photos of work or use drop off sites or self-addressed, stamped mail from the district.

Incorporate multiple opportunities to collect evidence of learning over time (e.g., project-based learning, voice recordings, artifacts, self-assessment, community service projects, interdisciplinary work, student-designed projects, rubrics).

Focus on holistic judgments that incorporate the totality of opportunities to learn and evidence of learning collected.

Consider the Big Picture -What is the essential evidence of learning is needed to earn credit for the Distance Learning for All time period?
