OR

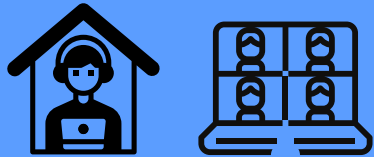
WLWV Online Program

Enroll through your regular school

Grades K-12

COMPREHENSIVE DISTANCE LEARNING

HYBRID MODEL (K-12) (A/B Rotation)



- Temporary Option: Students will eventually return in person to their regular school.
- Students will do remote learning at home taught by their WLWV teacher(s) and supported by a digital curriculum.
- Multiple synchronous learning opportunities offered each day.
- Daily school schedules and routines with students.
- Time with the teacher for check-ins and peer interactions.
- Consistent student feedback and assessment of learning, including letter grades.
- Peer-to-peer collaboration

- Half of students attend in-person classes at school
- Other half of students do connected and extended online learning at home



- Students would then switch roles the following day

Return to School Onsite Full Time

When Oregon Health Authority and Oregon Department of Education guidelines allow, and the district can ensure safety, students will return to daily regular in-person learning.



Fully virtual K-12 program



Virtual program where students complete all coursework at home, while having access to all the activities, athletics, clubs, virtual clubs and enrichment offered at their home school.

- 2020-21 full-year commitment expected for this option
- Comprehensive Digital Curriculum

Rigorous and dynamic curriculum and materials through FuelEd. District-provided Chromebook.

Taught by WLWV teacher(s)

Students work remotely with assigned WLWV teacher(s) and support staff.

- Diplomas Reflect Exceptional WLWV School District

Graduating seniors have access to counseling support for financial aid, scholarships, and post-high school planning. West Linn-Wilsonville High School of enrollment will be named on the transcript and earned diploma.
