NEW SAFETY COMMITTEE ISSUES:

1. Tim reported that parents are contacting him regarding issues around picking up/dropping off students. There is an issue due to parents insisting on driving their kids to school when they could ride the bus or use safe routes to school. This will continue to be an issue as long as

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parents continue to drive kids to school. When we receive these complaints, they are forwarded to the City to review.

- 2. Dundee bypass Where Wilsonville Road meets Hwy 219, the City of Wilsonville is engaged in reviewing this bypass plan. We are engaged in this process due to the location near our schools and will send a letter.
- 3. Quarterly Inspections These are safety inspections that should be done at each site. Schools have not been performing these inspections when reminded. We must come up with a way to get these done to meet regulations. We could continue to have Special Districts perform one per year of these inspections at each site. How do we make sure these are being done the rest of the year? One way is to have one of our District Safety Committee members perform these inspections. This would become an agenda item in our District Safety Committee meetings ongoing. Mark Law will take charge of this, working with Cindy to get reports ready. What we've been doing has not succeeded. There is value beyond compliance. We want our buildings to be safe.
- 4. Pat reported that signage is completed at Wood to direct with safety in mind.
- 5. There was some discussion about parking spaces. The committee suggested that the SRO's park in various places, rather than in a designated parking spot, so that it is not known whether they are in the school or not. The SRO's will begin this practice right away.
