- 1. Intercom System We have a new intercom system at Rosemont, Wood and WLHS. It has the capability to push a button to lock doors, sent out verbal announcements, send notification to Administration, staff, 911 and police. We are accessing all buildings for speakers so every space people can hear. Curt has been working on communication software and hardware. The system has also been used for bell schedule and can do daily announcements. It has a feature where you can push a button using a cell phone. Tim shared that the inconsistency shows itself during drills and has been documented and reported. Principals have been good about letting Tim know how drills went.
- 2. Operations received written communication from the WHS trainer. Tim, Pat, and Cindy met with Dennis Burke to get some clarification of what was reported as safety concerns. Tim will address each one in written form and cc the Safety Committee.
- 3. Athey Creek has new electronic reader board.
