Tim shared concern that when kids are in porches they could be seen from anywhere. Tim said we would solve this issue at both locations for these eight unique classrooms. Pat will install blinds. ## **NEW SAFETY COMMITTEE ISSUES:**

New Safety issues:

1. Pat observed lock in drills and Bolton and Sunset. Bolton went well but no voice in corridors. Sunset did not go well. Could not hear in corridors. A couple of teachers reported not hearing it on their phones even though they knew it was going to happen. Sunset does not have a functioning intercom. Mark said the library is a fish bowl. Pat added that there is no place to hide in the library so he suggested to Lisa that they go in the gym.

3. Pat reported that Doug Nimrod has started putting outside window identification stickers in the schools. Approx. \$10,000.00 for stickers. 4. Wheelchair safety issue was resolved: Paula/Pat reported that a wheelchair tipped over with student in it. A temporary solution has been put in place for this year. Next year, this class will be moved to another room at the school. Tim said that Parent Street at Bolton is closed off during the day while it is used as playground. Neighborhood walkers want to walk through. IA's at the school are concerned about unidentified people walking through during the school day. Tim working with city on sidewalk. Sidewalk will be created summer 2014, new bus drop off and parent pick-up plan. Tim will meet with Bolton parent about specific concern. Tim said that there is going to be a traffic light installed this summer at the Rosemont/Salamo intersection. Conern about safe route to schools. Parent wants sidewalk down Skyline. Tim will meet with parent to discuss concerns. 6.7. Pat brought up people at Athey Creek parking in the red curb zone. Officer cannot ticket cars parked in the red zone because this is private property. Towing companies will not tow cars unless we have signs posted. Pat said he is going to post towing signs at the site entrances of each school.

2. Tim has seen several schools do several drills together. Officer Keen said the State has not

put together protocol on how to carry out drills.
