New Safety issues:

 Paula has a few items to add to the Crisis Flip charts. One involves making a copy of the student's Data Verification Form whenever 911 is called. The other is addressing the steps to take for bloodborne pathogens exposure.
 5.21.14: we will cand out a cofety memory. Paula will help write. These will be cant out quarterly.

5-21-14: we will send out a safety moment. Paula will help write. These will be sent out quarterly and will include links to forms.

- 2. Officer Dan Kraus reported that a new SRO Officer, Patrick Finn, will be serving at Wilsonville High School. He comes with 30 years of experience. He will begin in the Fall.
- 3. It was noted that when 9-1-1 is called, the District needs to be notified. There were a couple incidents where officers were present and officers called 9-1-1 with their radio and the call did not go into our system to where notification went out. If someone (school staff) observes the officers addressing an emergency, they need to activate the school notification system.
