NEW SAFETY COMMITTEE ISSUES/DISCUSSION:

1. District has added 2 positions at both West Linn & Wilsonville High School. They will be Safety Custodian positions – they will make sure the doors on the perimeter of the buildings are closed & locked throughout the school day.

- a. Struggling to fill these positions. Currently staffing with maintenance employees but need to figure out a long term plan so our maintenance staff members can do their regular jobs.
2. AEDs for Football Stadiums. Should we have AEDs that are located in the football stadiums? They could get tampered with or run out of battery from being outside. Any solutions please bring forward via email to Pat.
 - a. People will continue to use the portable AEDs because there isn't really a solution of putting a permanent one
3. ERT members in schools. District is doing some ERT trainings and hopeful to get more members added to the ERTs at each school. Would like building engineers to be included in these trainings (should have another training before the end of the year as well as Jan/Feb).
4. District has engaged with True North (formerly Elert & Associates) to have them come back and reevaluate schools and provide further safety/security recommendations. We should add a new tab for True North as there will be lots of conversation around this.
