

NEW SAFETY COMMITTEE ISSUES/DISCUSSION:

- Isolation space in buildings (OAR 581-022-2220): The new ORS states that the district needs to provide a designated isolation space in all buildings. The district also has to train 1 staff member per every 60 students in a building. We do have until the end of the school year to address these items.
- Cleaning sprays in buildings: Staff need to ask for cleaning sprays and cannot bring their own products into the schools. District should communicate to staff these requirements and let them know that all Building Engineers can provide staff with cleaning supplies.
- Scents and fragrances in schools: There have been a lot of staff members bringing in plugins and fragrance spray cans. The district will communicate to staff that plugins are not allowed and will be taken if used in schools.
