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 For COVID people should isolate for 5 days. Day 0 through Day 5, so actually need to be home for 6 days. Schools needing more PPE. All schools should be stocked & building engineers should know where PPE is located. Benefits meeting on 9/28 at Stafford – they will be giving free flu shots. 10.19.2022 Air quality, yesterday 10/18. OSHA guidelines state you need to notify students/staff at certain air quality index points. OSAA also has their own guidelines for sports. District will continue to monitor air quality for the next few days. 11.16.2022 Have seen an increase in RSV cases so district will communicate out to staff ways that we can keep everyone safe. 12.21.2022 No updates at this time. 		
 Drills 6.15.2022 Almost done with drills for the year! We have three schools that need to complete their June fire drills and then we will be done. 		
 7.20.2022 All drills have been completed for the year! Saw a progression throughout the year with drills. Operations staff working to update the Standard Response Protocol posters and booklets throughout the buildings. 9.21.2022 Drills have been going well. All schools have completed their first fire drill and most are completing their lockdown drills. 10.19.2022 Drills have been going well. District personnel has noticed that people are more prepared and the mindset has shifted about doing drills and being prepared for emergencies. 11.16.2022 Drills are going well. Getting through the drills that are needed before schools go on Winter Break. Might be a good idea to do some ERT drills at the schools. Pat to ask leadership about this. 12.21.2022 Boones Ferry (Lockdown drill) and Crest (Secure drill) participated in a joint drill together. This is the first time Crest has done a drill on their own. Both drills went well. We've had feedback from schools about students feeling anxious when they don't know about drills beforehand. Schools will start announcing drills over the intercom system 15 to 30 seconds before actual drill, in belief that this will help calm and reassure students who are anxious about drills. The community member was arrested by Portland Police and charged with identity theft and burglary. Staff members will be reminded to be aware of unattended people walking through buildings.
