Continuing to have meetings regarding the radon results and the solutions the district can provide to mediate or minimalize the radon levels. During the summer the district will be making adjustments to the control side as well as fan speeds to achieve the right balance to keep	
	the radon levels low but also still providing heat to the building.

•	Continuing the use of the continuous radon monitors at Lourie. Currently testing in the C porch and all results lately have been below the threshold. Will continue to test and will also test during	
	the summer.	
•	Testing lead in water at 6 locations. Have tested at Willamette, Trillium, Bolton, Cedaroak, Stafford and Boeckman. We have received some results back of tests being over the threshold. When we receive those, we remove and replace the fixture that tested above the threshold, after replacing we retest.
