	Testing the C-porch at Lowrie at different intervals and seeing how the results correlate to the HVAC settings and different time		
	intervals. Continuing to have meetings regarding the radon results		
	and the solutions the district can provide to mediate or minimalize		
1	the radon levels.		

• During the summer the district will be making adjustments to the control side as well as fan speeds to achieve the right balance to keep the radon levels low but also still providing heat to the building.

5.17.2023

- Continuing the use of the continuous radon monitors at Lourie. Currently testing in the C porch and all results lately have been below the threshold. Will continue to test and will also test during the summer.
- Testing lead in water at 6 locations. Have tested at Willamette, Trillium, Bolton, Cedaroak, Stafford and Boeckman. We have received some results back of tests being over the threshold. When we receive those, we remove and replace the fixture that tested above the threshold, after replacing we retest.

6.21.2023

- Have tested 6 schools for lead and water in regards to the HASS plan. 5 of the 6 schools are 100% clear and one school remaining, Stafford, one fixture had to replaced and retested.
- Lowrie radon temporary mitigation efforts during the Spring were effective. Working through the summer with partners to achieve a more permanent solution. Will be using continuous radon monitors throughout the summer to see what adjustments occur.

7.19.2023

- Continuing with radon monitoring at Lowrie PS. Maintenance team will be meeting on 7/27 to discuss how things are going for the summer testing.
- Have completed all testing at six schools for lead/water testing and all schools have passed their testing.

9.20.2023

- Radon monitoring at Lowrie is ongoing. All of the changes from the Spring are still in effect. The testing period is coming up in October. Lowrie's entire building will be tested for radon starting on October 9th
- Lead testing will be continuing this fall. Jeremy to update as we start testing specific sites.

NEW SAFETY COMMITTEE ISSUES/DISCUSSION:

- The School Board has adopted a new chemical that can be used on trees to prevent pesticides. The chemical name is mectitine. The White Oak tree at Wilsonville HS will be injected with this chemical today.
- OSHA is going to be more active in their inspection and enforcement actions. They would like districts to investigate all accidents and every injury report. The Safety Committee will be tasked with investigating those.
- Safety and Security Supervisor, Jeremy Nicholas, has been appointed to the District Safety Leadership Team.
