### NEW SAFETY COMMITTEE ISSUES/DISCUSSION:

- 1. District has added 2 positions at both West Linn & Wilsonville High School. They will be Safety Custodian positions they will make sure the doors on the perimeter of the buildings are closed & locked throughout the school day.
  - a. This position is growing and changing a little. Hopeful to get these positions filled quickly.
- 2. District received a request to start using air conditioning in gym spaces. However, the only gym that has AC is Wilsonville HS. Community Services will be modifying the Terms & Conditions for facility use to let renters know that there will not be AC in gyms and people reserving gyms should act accordingly or be aware that no AC will be provided.
- 3. AEDs for Football Stadiums. Should we have AEDs that are located in the football stadiums? They could get tampered with or run out of battery from being outside. Any solutions please bring forward via email to Pat.
