Water Quality Information

Dear West Linn High School Families,

As you know, the West Linn-Wilsonville School District is testing the water in all schools this summer. As each school's lab results are made available to the District, they are being shared with families in that school.

The results from testing at West Linn High School show that out of 185 interior test locations, five indicated elevated levels of lead that exceed the action level of 20 parts per billion and one indicated elevated levels of copper that exceed the action level 1,350 parts per billion. The elevated levels of lead are two classroom sink faucets, a laundry room sink faucet, a lab sink faucet, and a bubbler in a classroom porch area. The elevated levels of copper are in a drinking fountain.

Immediate remediation steps taken include turning water off at these locations, replacing subject fixtures and retesting. These results will be sent out to you once all remediation steps are complete.
