Water Quality Information

Dear Wilsonville High School Families,

As you know, the West Linn-Wilsonville School District is testing the water in all schools this summer. As each school's lab results are made available to the District, they are being shared with families in that school.

The results from testing at Wilsonville High School show that out of 203 test locations, two indicated elevated levels of lead that exceed the action level of 20 parts per billion and two indicated elevated levels of copper. The elevated levels of lead are in a sink faucet in a kitchen area and in a sink faucet in a shower room. The elevated levels of copper are in two lab sinks in classrooms. Immediate remediation steps taken include turning water off at these locations, replacing subject fixtures and retesting. These results will be sent out to you once all remediation steps are complete. The remediation and retesting will occur before children return to school this fall.
