Water Quality Information

August 16, 2016

Dear Wood Middle School Families,

This letter is being sent to update you about the water quality testing results that were shared on July 21, 2016. The initial results from July testing at Wood Middle School showed that out of 109 test locations, 13 indicated elevated levels of lead that exceeded the action level of 20 parts per billion. This included 8 lab sinks in science classrooms, 1 teacher demonstration lab sink, 3 classroom sink faucets, and 1 bubbler in a classroom sink.

Immediate remediation steps were taken include turning water off at these locations, replacing subject fixtures, and retesting. After remediation, water was retested on August 4. All fixtures tested below the action level of 20 ppb. These results have cleared all fixtures at Wood Middle School for elevated levels of lead or copper.
