- Co:Writer is available across multiple platforms.
- It can be used on a Mac or PC desktop, iOS device, an extension in Chrome, and as an App for Chrome

Having students use Co:Writer Universal

- Open Co:Writer Universal
- Select Sign in with Google
- Student enters their school email and password

Chromebooks

- The chromebooks have the chrome app and extension installed. If you do not see the extension, open up chrome, click on the folder with bookmarks and select Get Co:Writer Extension. Follow the prompts to load the extension. Then you will see the co:writer bubble to the right of the address bar in chrome.
