## **Organizing for Specially Designed Instruction**

There are a range of ways to ensure that students receive Specially Designed Instruction. Three ways to structure the delivery of specially designed instruction are **co-planning** for inclusive instruction, **co-teaching** in the general education classroom, and **instruction in an alternative location**. This document is intended to provide some guidance for Learning Specialists to plan for how to ensure that students receive Specially Designed Instruction.

- 1. Review student needs in partnership with general ed teacher/team
  - Which students have each area of SDI at each grade level?
  - What is the intensity of need for each student in this content level?
    - How will the student participate in gen ed in this content area?
    - Will the student need pre-teaching to access content?
    - Is any modified curriculum needed (such as Unique Learning Systems)?
- 2. Review student and teacher schedules
  - Which students receiving SDI are in the same classrooms/periods?
  - When are gen ed teacher teaming times and prep periods?
- 3. Consider your schedule, other learning specialists' schedules, paraprofessional/IA schedules
- 4. Develop a draft plan for ensuring SDI for all students on your caseload, which is likely to include all of the following:
  - Some co-planning where the SDI is delivered by gen ed teachers or paraprofessionals/IAs
  - Some co-teaching
    - Every learning specialist should at least 1 period/section of co-teaching
    - The co-teaching partnership could last the full year, a semester, a quarter, or even a several week unit of instruction
    - One might go deep with one co-teaching partnership or rotate through several co-teaching partnerships to encourage capacity building
  - Some instruction in alternative location delivered by learning specialist or paraprofessionals/IAs
    - Pre-teaching content from general ed class
    - Work on foundational or access skills
- 5. Review draft with your SPED team, IC, or admin to get input
