Tax and Financial **Supports for Families** of Students with **Disabilities**

Families of students served by special education may qualify for certain tax and financial supports.

Oregon Tax Exemption

The Oregon tax code provides a tax exemption for parents of eligible children with disabilities (Early Intervention, Early Childhood Special **Education or School-Age Special** Education).

The procedure for claiming an exemption for the 2018 tax year is explained in the Oregon Individual Income Tax Guide (p. 98). Search for Publication OR-17 or go to http://www.oregon.gov/DOR/forms/ Pages/default.aspx and scroll to the Personal Income section to find Publication OR-17.

ABLE savings accounts

The federal government has established a tax-sheltered savings program for families of students with significant disabilities. The purpose of the ABLE account is to allow families to save for disability-related expenses without impacting their eligibility for federal benefits.
