Information for Parents

If your family lives in any of the following situations:

- In a shelter, motel, vehicle, or campground
- On a street
- In an abandoned building, trailer, or other inadequate accommodations, or
- Doubled up with friends or relatives because you cannot find or afford housing

Then, your preschool-aged and school-aged children have certain rights or protections under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act.

Your children have the right to:

- **Attend School**
 - Continue to attend the school they attended before becoming homeless
 - Receive the same public education, special programs and services, if needed, as provided to all other children
- **Transportation**
 - Receive transportation to and from the school they attended before your family became homeless
- **Activities**
 - Participate in school activities/sports at no cost to them
 - Have access to Afterschool Programs
 - Have access to Extracurricular Activities
- **Assistance in accessing resources**
 - Clothing
 - Food
 - School supplies
 - Shelter information
 - Medical needs
