Dear Trillium Creek Family and Friends:

We have completed our second week of school with flying, although smoky, colors. Speaking of the smoke, our students did a wonderful job adjusting to two days of indoor recesses. As a school district, we decided that limiting exposure to outside activities was in the best interest of our students and their health. We usually go outdoors, rain or shine, but this week we had to make an exception.

One of the many things that makes Trillium such a special school is our Morning Meeting time together. This is an all-school, daily meeting where we sing songs, celebrate birthdays, make announcements and even share some jokes on "Funny Fridays." Families are always welcome to join us for this experience. In fact, we value family presence as it represents the community of care we treasure as part of our culture. When Morning Meeting concludes, and before our students return to class, we ask that families exit the building first. Parents should feel welcome to remain outside the commons and on our front porch to finish their conversations or make connections with other families. We just need the adults to clear the way for our 600+ students to safely walk to class. This is very important for safety and security reasons. Our teachers must be able to keep their eyes on all of their students during this transition, and that becomes very difficult when students are trying to navigate around the many adults that remain in the commons. Let's also please remember to keep adult versations at a whisper level to allow our students to better listen to the program. Thank you all for helping us keep your children safe and secure and following this new dismissal protocol. I greatly appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

New WLWV District Volunteer Registration System!

With a new school year, comes a new and improved process for volunteer registration and sign-in. If you want to volunteer in any capacity at Trillium Creek then you need to register or re-register if you are a returning volunteer!

Simply visit http://www.helpcounter.net/wlwv and click start to fill out your application. Your registration will be received at the district office where it will be processed. Until your registration is processed, you won't be able to sign-in and volunteer at school. This process could take 2-3 days to complete. When the processing is complete, you will be notified by email.

Please register to volunteer! We have many volunteer opportunities coming up, including Backyard BBQ on September 15th!

The first time that you actually sign-in to volunteer at any of our schools, you will be prompted to accept a Volunteer Agreement. In order to speed up the sign-in process, please review the agreement ahead of time. Accepting of the agreement is a one-time task to be completed at any school.

As you complete the sign-in process each time you volunteer, the system will print a name badge for you. This needs to be worn at all times while you are serving in your volunteer capacity.

Volunteering in our schools is a very rewarding experience and we greatly appreciate it. Thank you!
