No problem! Come browse to see if you find a costume for a small fee of \$5.


Children who want to buy a costume but have to take the bus, can add their name to the list and just mark the "buy" box and we will make sure they can come to participate.

We are very excited about the beginning strings and intermediate orchestra program. A strong strings program starts at the primary level. Our goal is to provide instruction that will develop a lifetime of music, discipline, confidence, lasting friendships and accomplishment. We look forward to an amazing year of music and learning. To assist in making our strings program as accessible as possible, we are offering instruction at 2 district locations; with bus service provided to each location from your neighborhood school! (Parents are responsible for timely pickup after strings class). Primary Strings musicians and Orchestra members will participate in 2 concerts this year:

Tuesday, December 12 at Athey Creek Middle School (gym) and Thursday, May 17, 2018 at West Linn High School.

- When: Mondays & Wednesdays*, 2:30 3:15 pm. at Boeckman Creek Primary School
 (*no class on Professional Growth/Early Release days) Classes begin Monday, October 16.

- Instruments: Students can choose to play violin, viola, cello, or double bass. You will need to provide

- Intermediate Orchestra: Students must have completed one year of beginning strings or have at least one year of previous playing experience to enroll in Intermediate Orchestra.
