Spring Open House Student-Led Conferences

We hope that you will be able to join us for student-led conferences at the end of this month. As mentioned in an earlier newsletter and email, we will have a different format for our spring conferences this year. On March 24, classroom teachers will be offering an open house format with the ability to touch base with parents during that time. Although there will be a different format this year, the student-led nature of the conferences will be preserved.

During these student-led conferences, your child will have the opportunity to share their learning and their goals for the rest of the school year. Also, our intention is that each classroom teacher will connect with each family to celebrate achievements and share areas of continued growth. Because we have one day for conferences, there will be more than one family in the classroom at a time. Thank you for your understanding of this modified approach to spring conferences.

Classroom teachers will be sending out information specific to their classroom so you know when to come for your child's student-led conference. You should receive this information from your child's teacher the week of March 13. While Friday, March 24 has been set aside for conferences, some classrooms, due to extenuating circumstances, may offer conferences at other times.

If for some reason you are unable to attend your child's conference, your child's teacher will send home a portfolio so you will be able to view your child's work and goals.
