Dear Parents and Community Members,

The Oregon Department of Education has issued this report card to give a comprehensive view of your student compared to WLWV and the larger state.

During the 2012-13 school year, our average attendance was 98.9. This demonstrates a high level of commitment on the part every TRCS family. Overall, we earned a ranking on this report card of a 5, designating our school as within the top 10% of all schools in Oregon.

- 96% Met or Exceeded Reading Benchmarks (62% Exceeded)
- 96% Met or Exceeded Math Benchmarks (63% Exceeded)
- 86.5% Met or Exceeded Science Benchmarks (56.8% Exceeded)

We are now in the midst of a transition to the new Common Core

State Standards (CCSS), reinforcing integration of subjects across all curriculum areas beginning in the 2014-15 school year. As always, we will do our best to keep students at the heart of everything we do and continue to provide challenges, academically and personally.

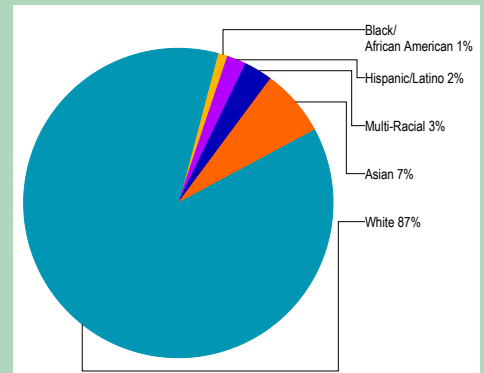

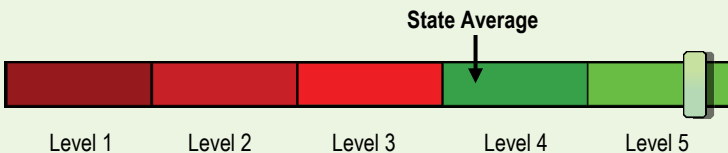


OVERALL STATE RATING

HOW ARE STUDENTS AT THIS SCHOOL PERFORMING COMPARED TO THOSE AT OTHER SCHOOLS?

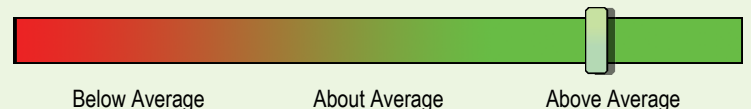

Compared to all schools statewide in 2012-13, this school is rated as Level 5.



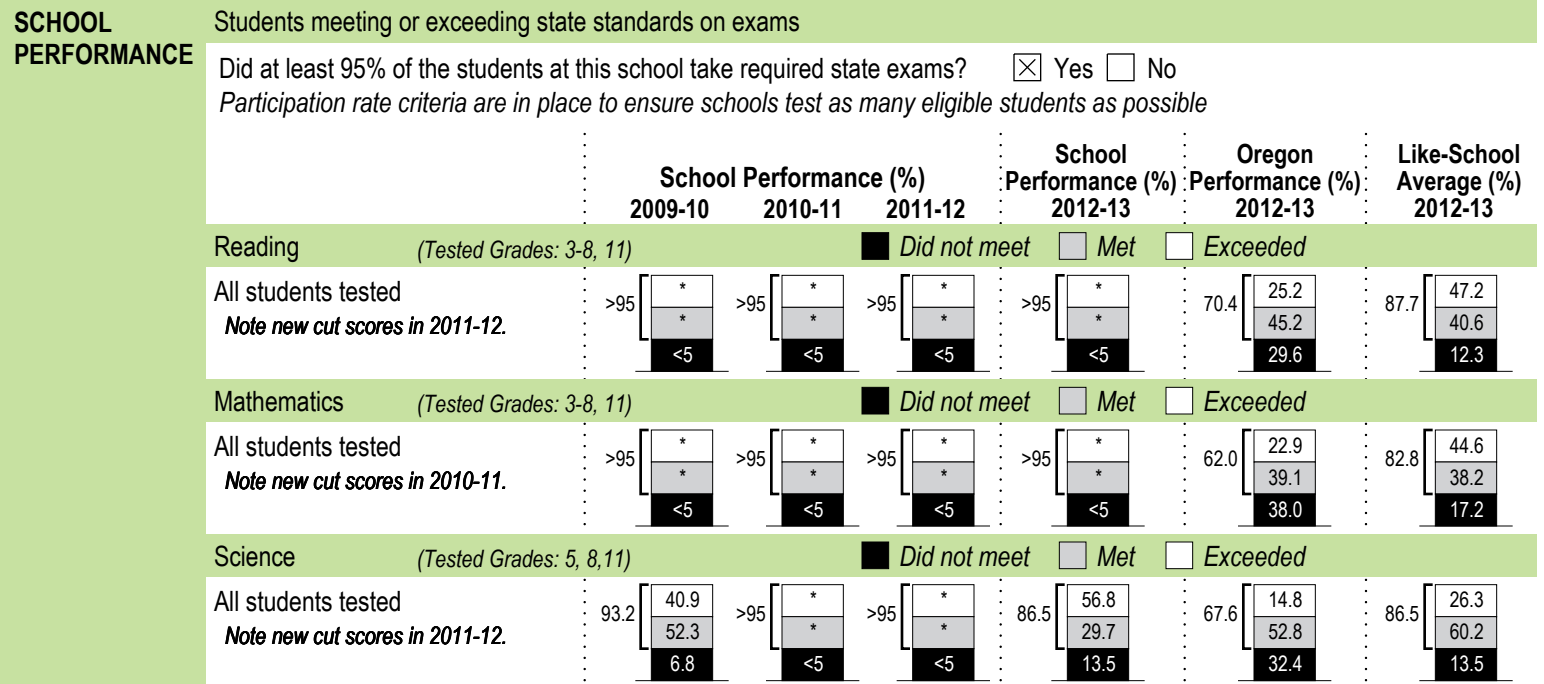
- Level 1** = Falls into the bottom 5% of schools

- Level 4** = Falls between 44% and 90% of schools
