
The Oregon School Report Card provides additional information. Rosemont Ridge's Overall State Rating of 4 indicates we meet targets for reading and math. However, as long as there is a



Level 1 = Falls into the bottom 5% of schools


Level 2 = Falls between 5% and 15% of schools
