This was the third year that the state of Oregon implemented the Smarter Balanced testing. Our students scored well on this year's testing:

- ·88% Met or Exceeded ELA Benchmarks (51% Exceeded)
- ·80% Met or Exceeded Math Benchmarks (56.4% Exceeded)
- ·95% Met or Exceeded Science Benchmarks (37.5% Exceeded)
