Creating Performing Responding Connecting

Singing a variety of repertoire alone and with others

- Perform on pitch, with appropriate timbre and posture, while maintaining a steady tempo
- Perform expressively, with appropriate dynamics and understanding of composer's intent
- Perform from memory and from developing notation, a varied repertoire of songs representing genres and styles from diverse cultures and historic periods while connecting to students' own experiences and background
- Perform basic ostinati (specific repeated patterns), rounds, and simple partner songs
- Perform in groups, blending vocal timbres, matching dynamic levels, while responding to the cues of a conductor
- Create simple patterns using specific pitches and rhythms in a group
- Create new verses to an existing song, connecting to prior knowledge

Playing on instruments a variety of repertoire, alone and with others

- Perform with accuracy, proper technique and posture, while maintaining a steady tempo and using appropriate dynamics
- Perform from memory and from notation, a varied repertoire representing genres and styles from diverse cultures and historic periods while connecting to students' own experiences and background
- Perform and create simple accompaniments using a variety of instruments
- Perform in ensembles, listening and responding to each other and a conductor
- Create simple patterns using specific pitches and/or rhythms, independently or in a group

- Perform, within a group, a choreographed dance
- Create and perform patterns using body percussion or props
- Respond to music and each other through a variety of expressive movements
- Build physical and emotional connections in a positive way through community movement
