Creating Performing Responding Connecting

Singing a variety of repertoire alone and with others

- Perform with an expanding vocal range, maintaining appropriate technique
- Perform and accompany oneself with an instrument, body percussion, or movement.
- Perform from memory and notation, a varied repertoire of songs representing genres and styles from diverse cultures and historic periods, while making connections to students' own experiences and background
- Perform two part vocal works, blending vocal timbres, responding to the cues of a conductor
- Responding to others within a group setting through use of dynamics, blending voices, expression, phrasing, and interpretation
- Create a vocal piece using specific parameters, independently or in a group
- Create lyrics to an original composition or existing melody, connecting to personal experiences

Playing on instruments a variety of repertoire, alone and with others

- Perform independently with accuracy, proper technique, and posture, while maintaining a steady tempo
- Perform expressively, with appropriate dynamics, phrasing and interpretation
- Perform from memory and from notation, a varied repertoire representing genres and styles from diverse cultures and historic periods while connecting to students' own experiences and background
- Create and perform accompaniments, within specific guidelines based on experience and content knowledge
- Perform in multi-part ensembles, listening and responding to each other and a conductor
- Create and perform improvisations and compositions using specific parameters, independently or in a group, evaluating their own work and those of their peers

Movement

- Perform, within a group, complex choreographed dances
- Create and perform patterns using multi-level body percussion or props
- Respond to music and each other through a variety of expressive movements
- Build physical and emotional connections in a positive way through community movement
