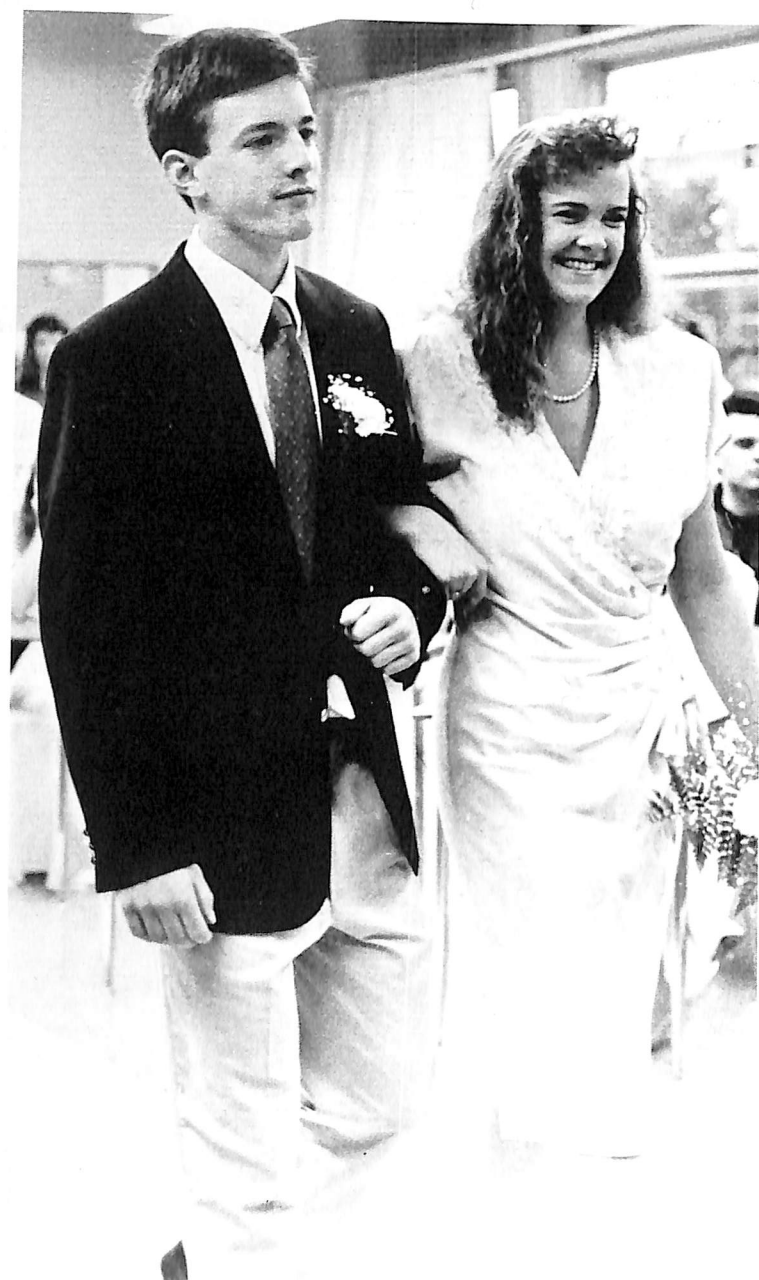

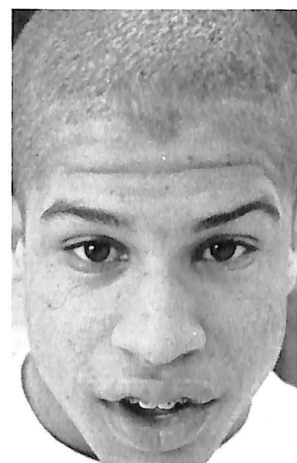

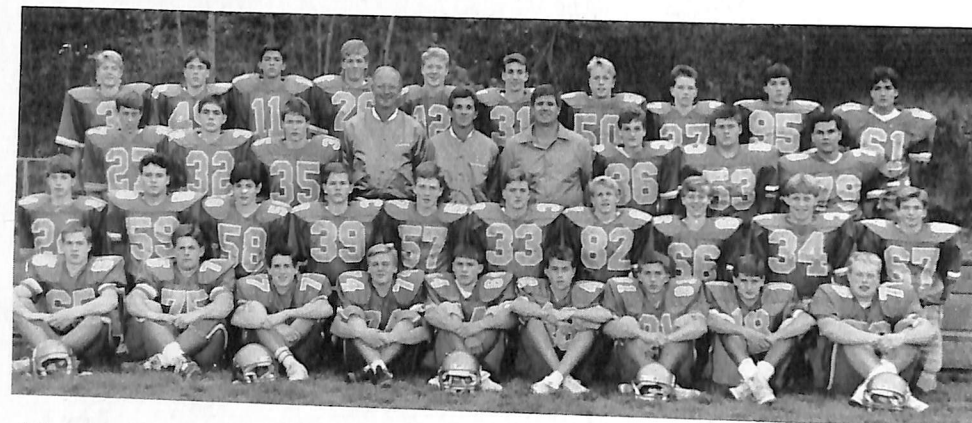

On behalf of the seniors I want to wish the team continued success. We respect you all as players and friends, and as we move on you will forever be in our thoughts and memories.

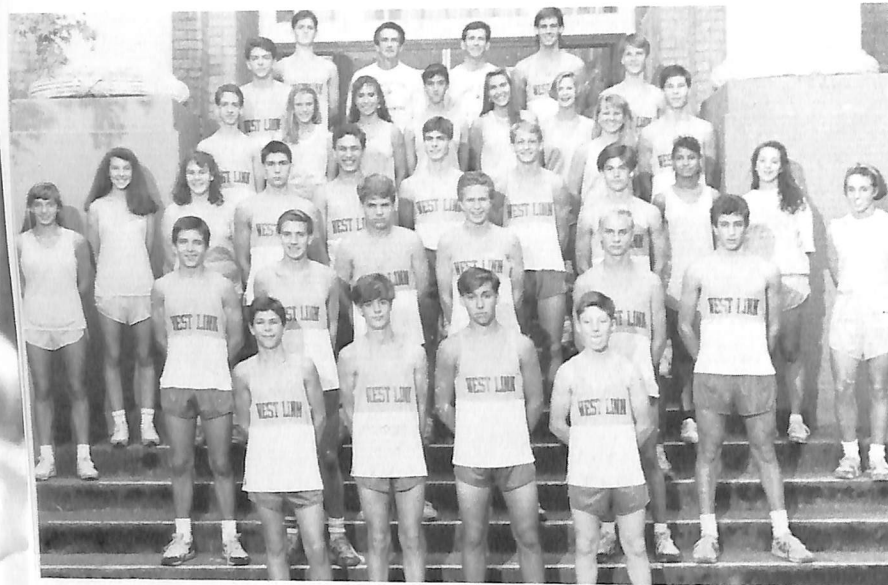

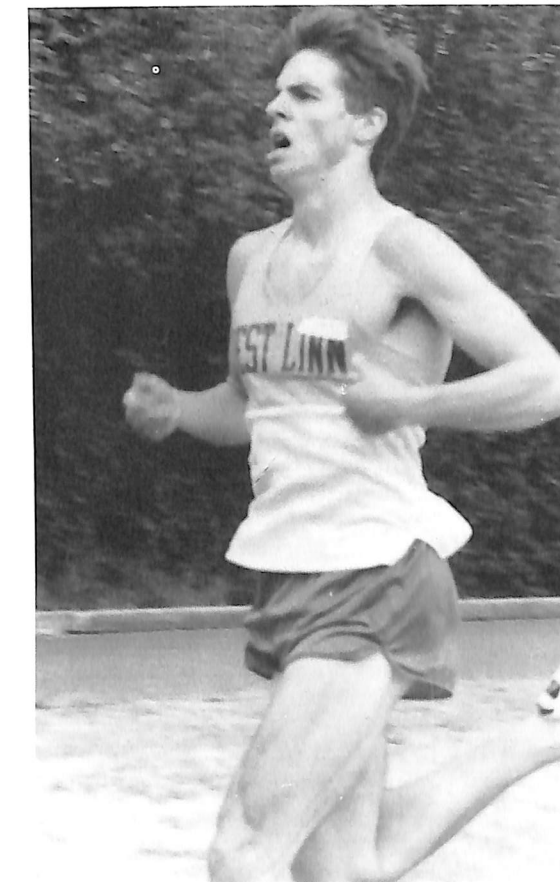

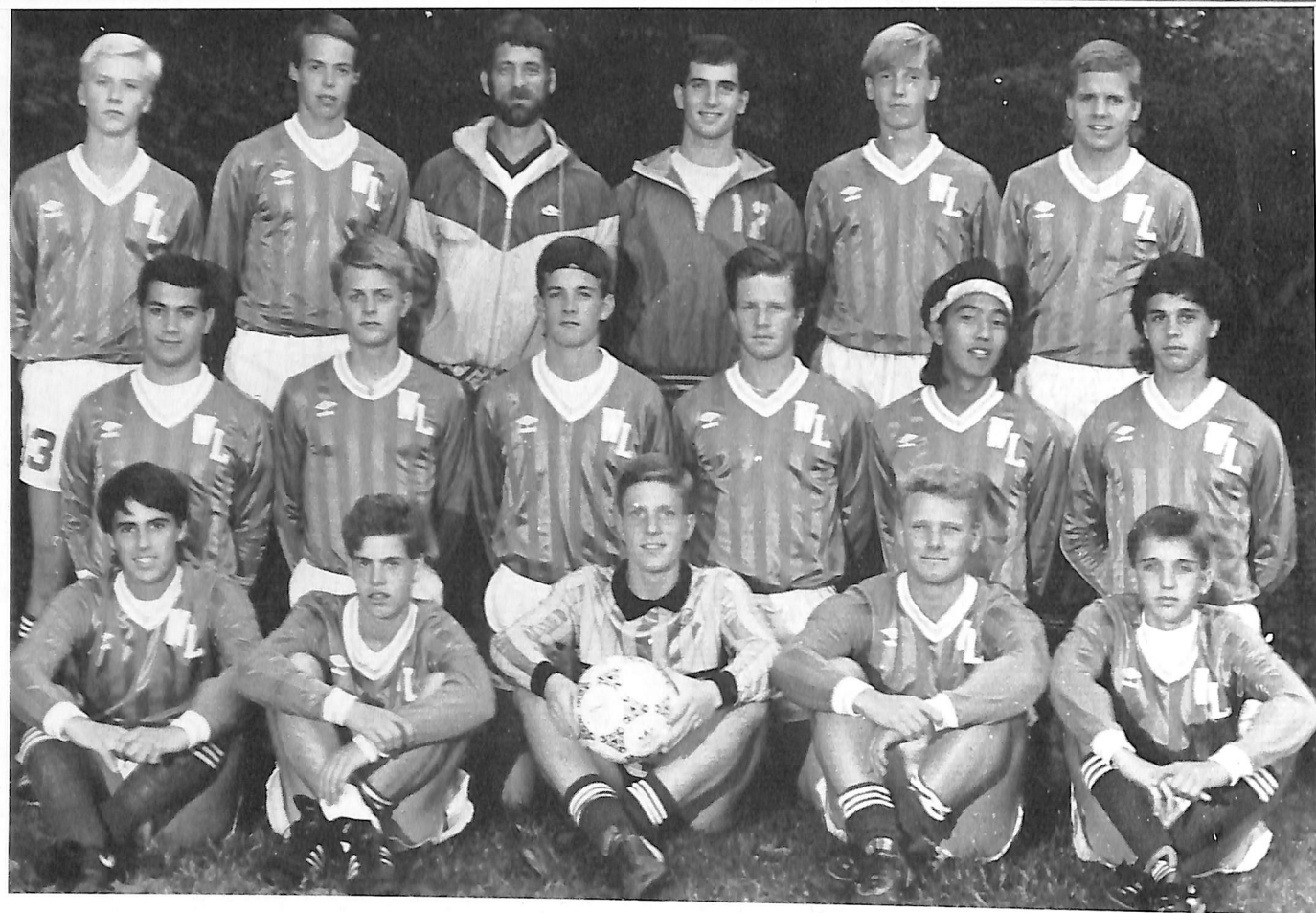


This season started out in the mid-August heat. The first week was a hard conditioning week followed by the second week of a little easier conditioning.

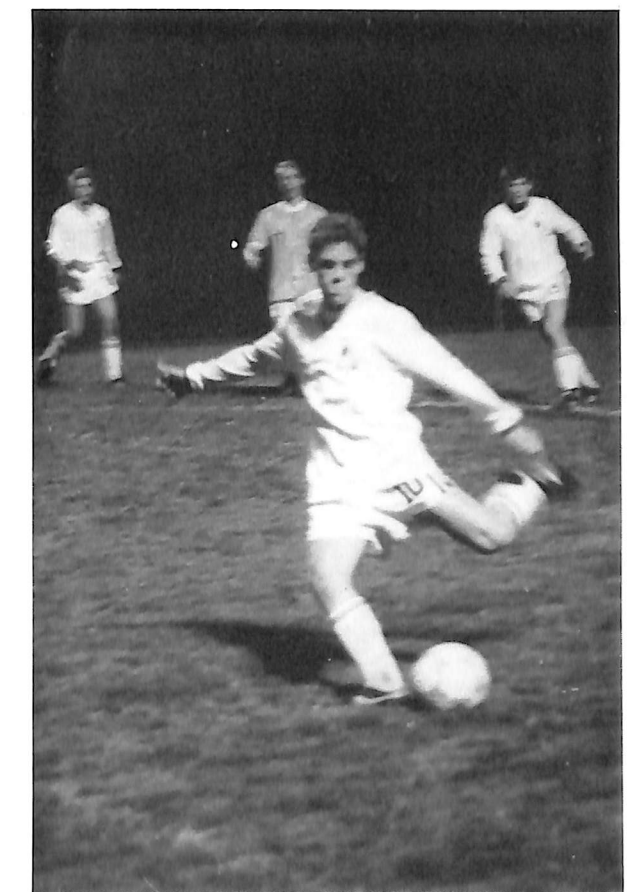

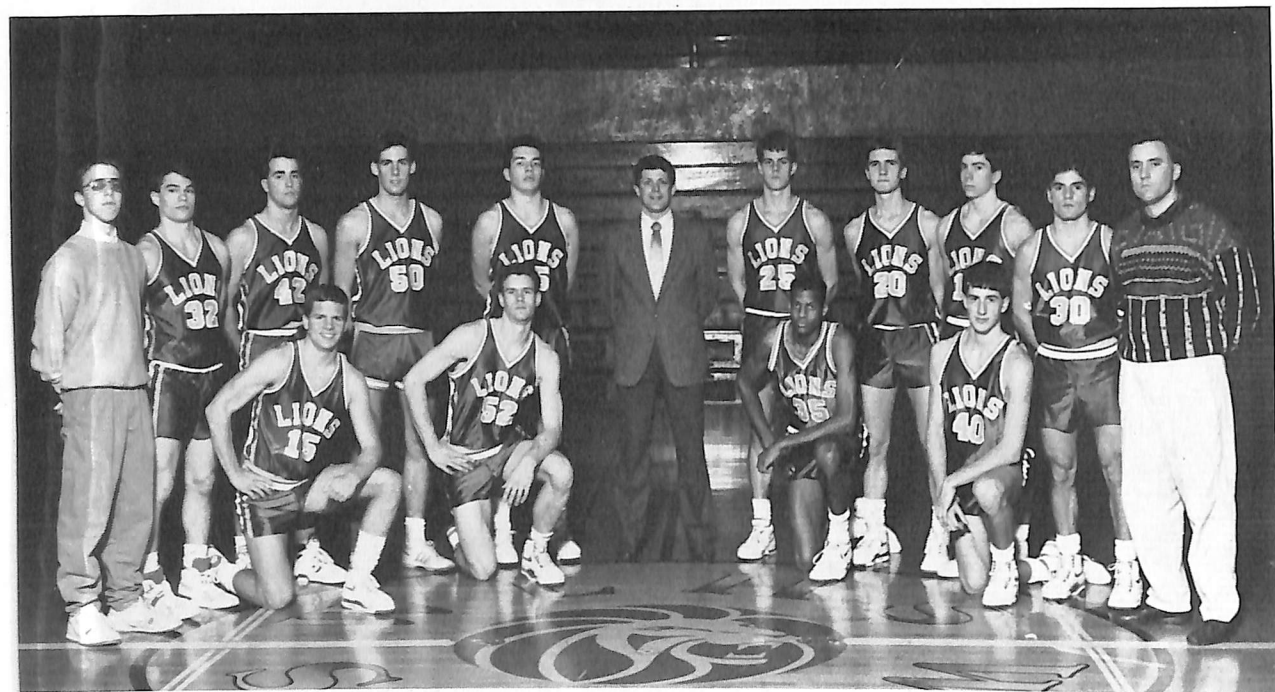

At the beginning of the season we set the goals for our team and tops on the list was to bring home a trophy. We never lost sight of that goal.

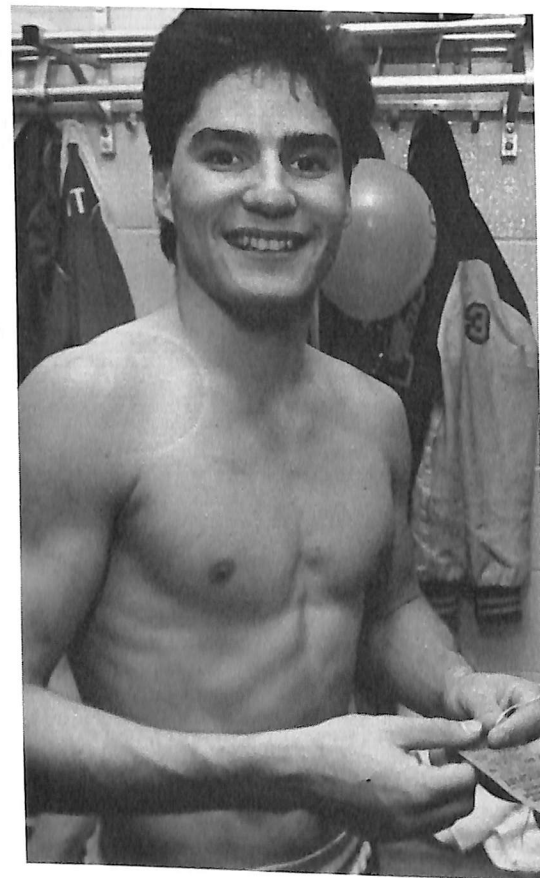

This was a great season for everyone involved. It was a dream come true and something that I will remember for the rest of my life.

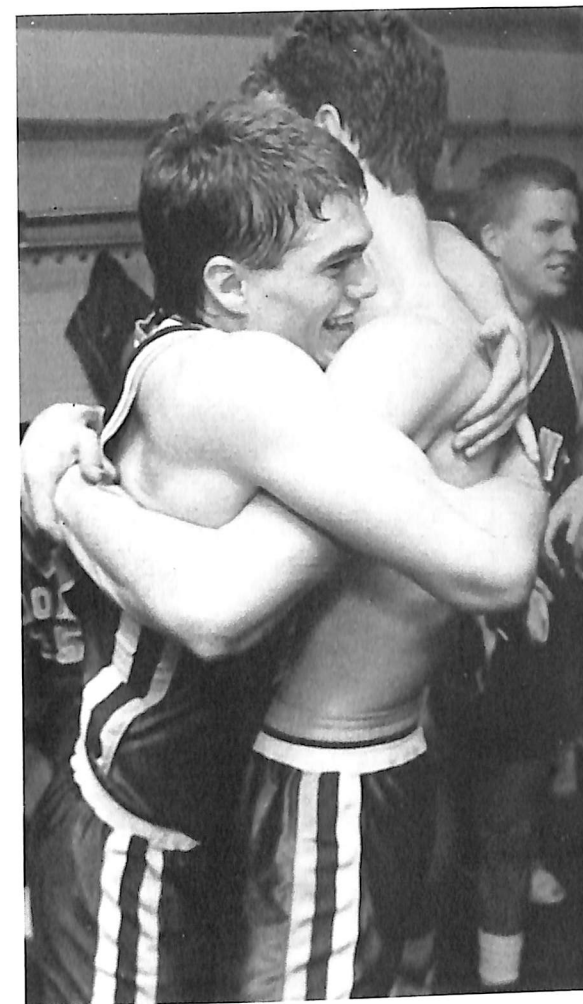

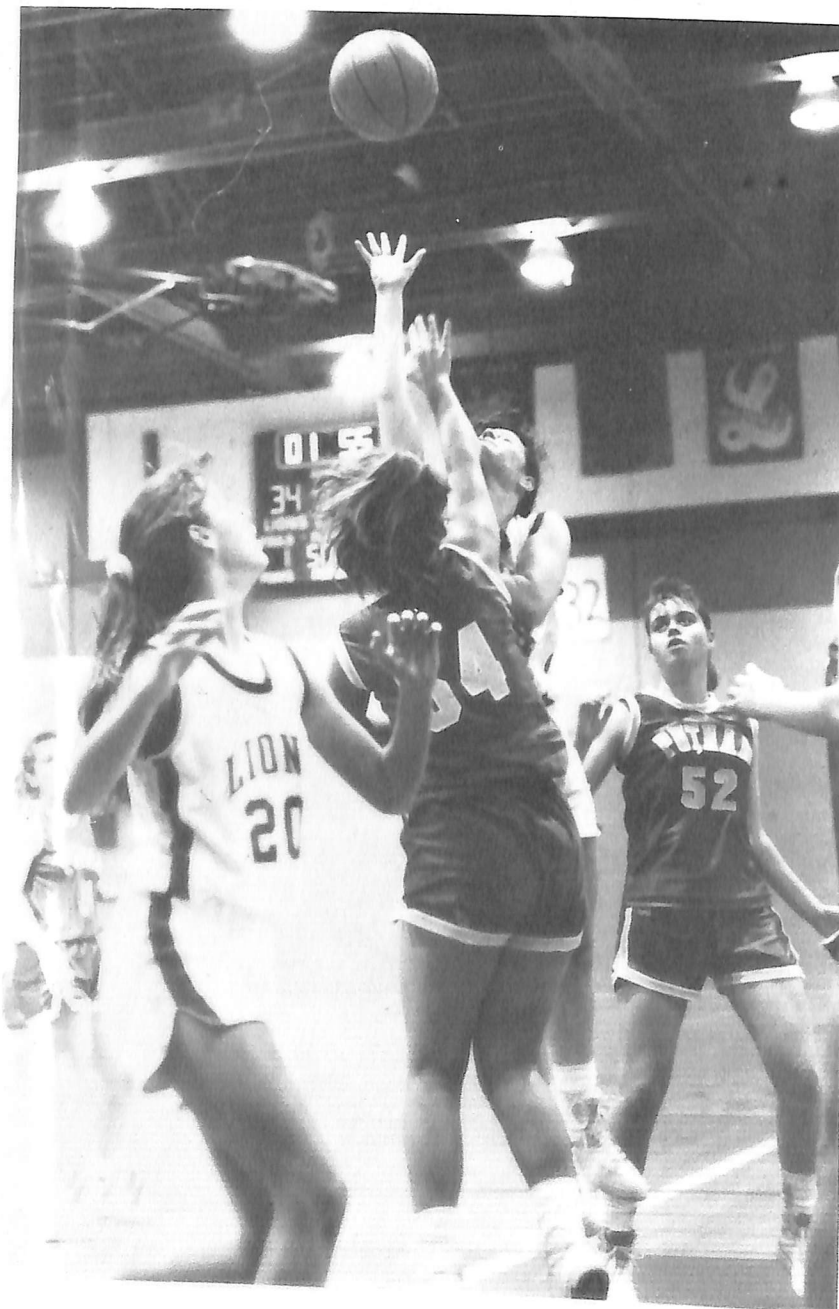

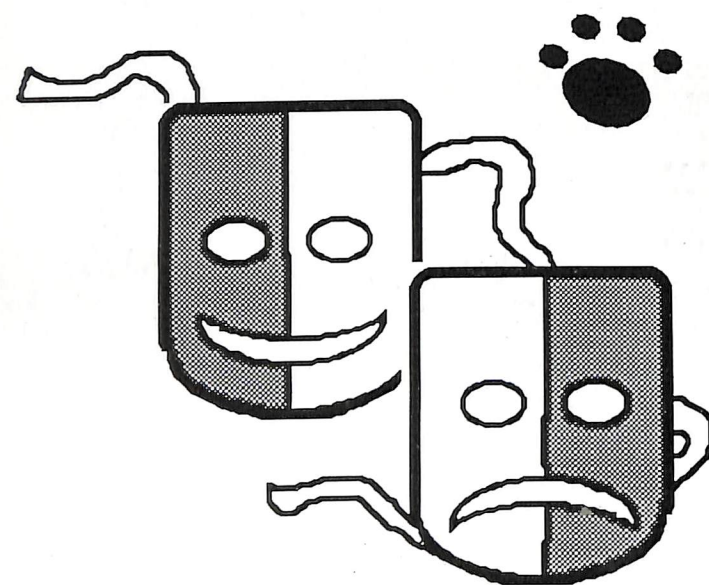

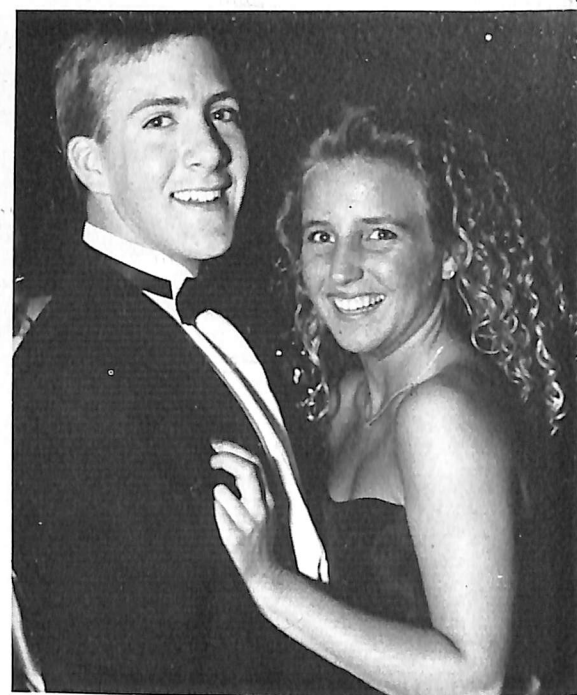

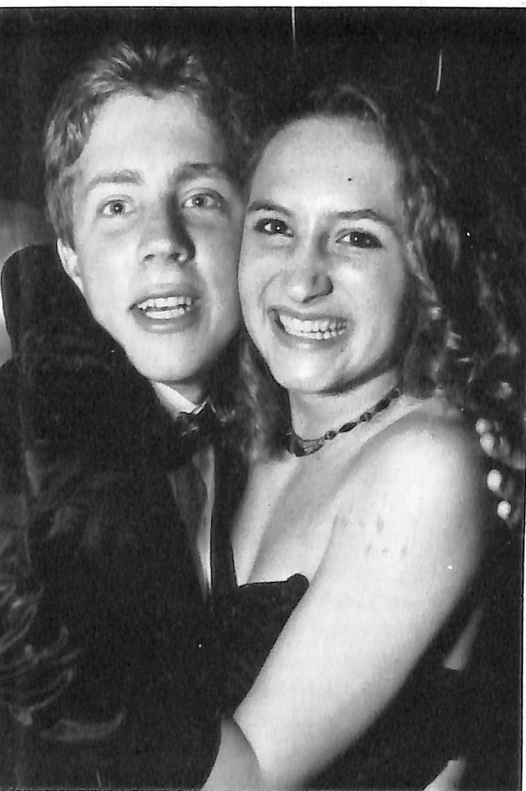

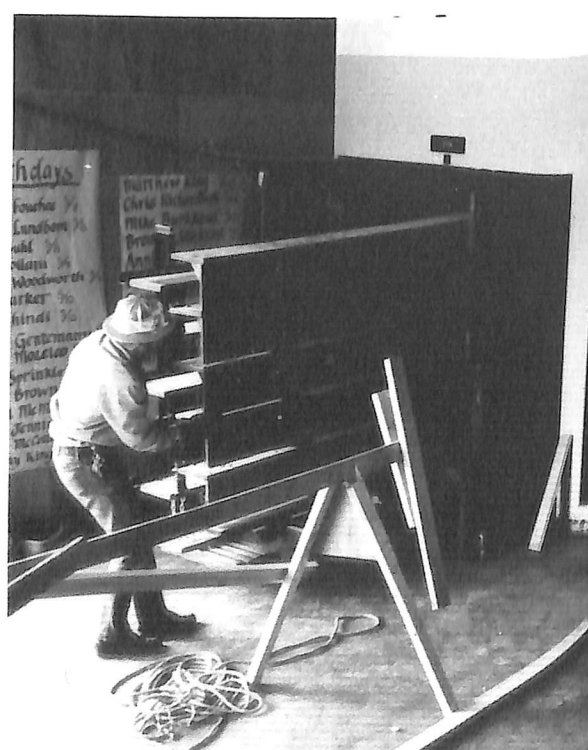
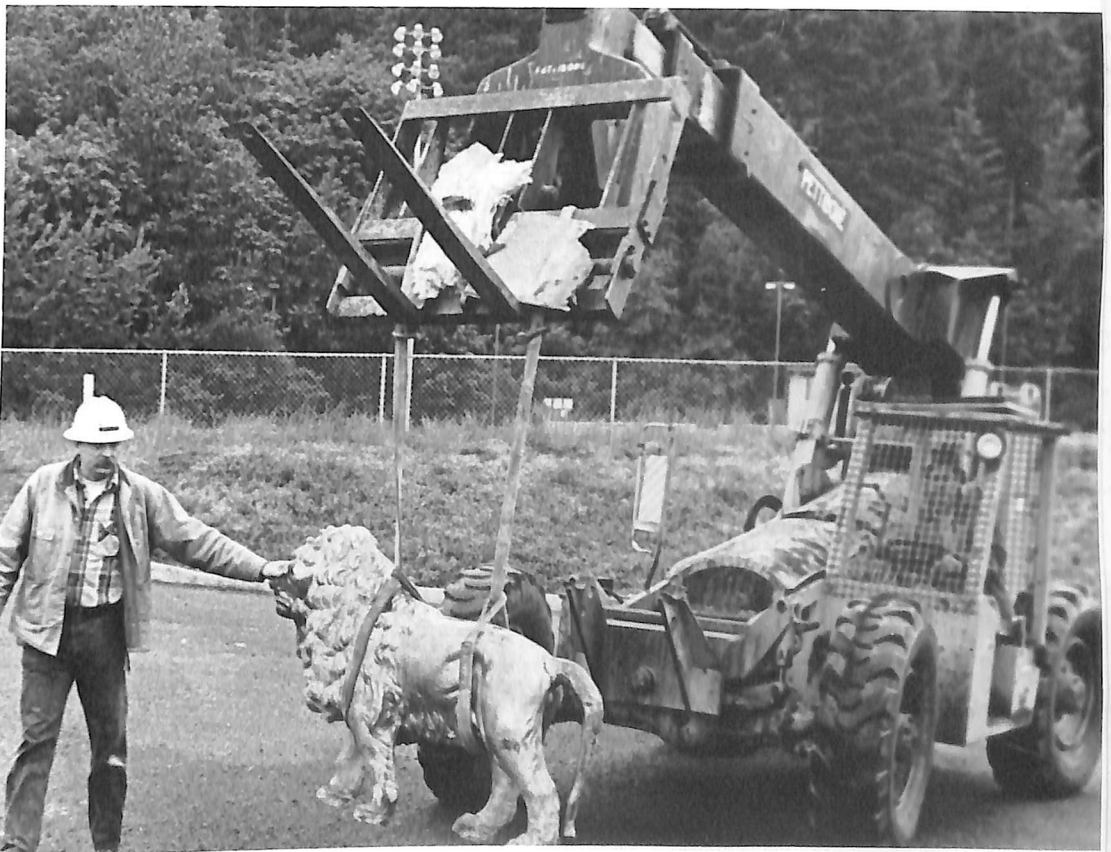




CONSTRUCTION
