






The attitude of the players is what held the team together, according to Coach Ron Chappell. "Our team captains set the tone for the team with hard work and enthusiasm."








The squad expirenced many fun moments together this year. From dancing with the football players at assemblies, to potluck diners before the games, each member ended the season with new memories.










As if two state championships in a row wasn't enough, the defending state champion Lion boys track team, under Coach Jon Brickey, brought home its third consecutive state title from Eugene. The Lions were the fourth team in the history of Oregon to accomplish the feat of three-in-a-row. "It's not every day that kids get a chance to make history -- and to win three state championships in a row is amazing," said Brickey.
