Self-Medication Agreement

Students who are developmentally and/or behaviorally able will be allowed to self-administer prescription and non- prescription medication without the assistance of trained school personnel, subject to the following:

1. A Medication Authorization form must be submitted for self-medication of all prescription and non-prescription medication.
2. For self carried emergency medication (inhalers, epinephrine auto injectors, etc), parents are expected to provide “back-up” supply of each in the school health office.
3. All prescription and nonprescription medication must be kept in its appropriately labeled, original container, as follows:
  - The Student may have in his possession only the amount of medication needed for that particular school day.
  - Prescription labels must specify the name of the student, name of the medication, dosage, route and frequency of time of administration and any other special instructions.
  - Non prescription medication must have the student's name affixed to the original container
4. Sharing and/or borrowing of medication with another student is strictly prohibited.
5. Permission to self-medicate may be revoked if the student violates school district policy governing administration of non-injectable medication and/ or these regulations. Additionally, student may be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion as appropriate.
